### AI-Driven Automation Pipelines

PERSONAL PROJECT

*Jan 2023 – Present*

Wrote Python tooling that wires LLMs into everyday work. Most of the effort went into the unglamorous part: tight system prompts and strict JSON schemas that make the output reliable enough to parse and act on without checking it by hand. The kind of hands-on agent and SDK work that's a lot easier to explain to other developers once you've actually shipped it.

### Declarative Infrastructure & Self-Hosting Environment

PERSONAL PROJECT

*Nov 2016 – Present*

Run a homelab that hosts dozens of my own internet-facing services on VMware ESXi, KVM, and Docker. The whole thing is defined in NixOS and Flakes, so the setup is reproducible and I can rebuild a machine from scratch and get exactly what I had before. It's also where every demo and sample I write gets tested before anyone else sees it.

### Typst-Generated Content Pipeline

PERSONAL PROJECT

*Oct 2024 – Present*

Built the system that generates this resume. It's written in Typst, and a GitHub Actions pipeline compiles and publishes several tailored variants from shared metadata, so a fact updated in one place fans out everywhere it's used. A small, real example of treating docs and content like code: version controlled, reviewed, and shipped on every push.

### Enterprise-Grade Network Architecture & Security

PERSONAL PROJECT

*Aug 2019 – Present*

Built and run the network behind all of this on a FortiGate firewall: separate DMZs, isolated VLANs, and MetalLB load balancing in front of the public-facing services. Nothing trusts anything by default, which keeps a problem in one corner from spreading to the rest.
